Graham was a past commander for the post back in 1967. He will truly be missed.

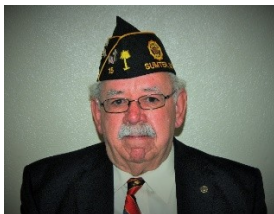
Adjutant: Rifle raffle tickets turned in and drawings have started but as of yet Post 15 has no winners.

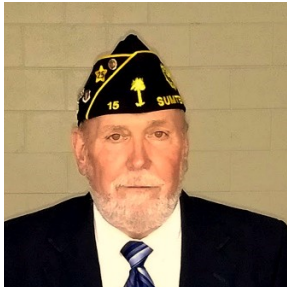


From our Chaplain... We had 2 members transferred to Post Everlasting: Robert E. Tomes and John M. Graham.
