riding in a patrol car as they went through driver training techniques.

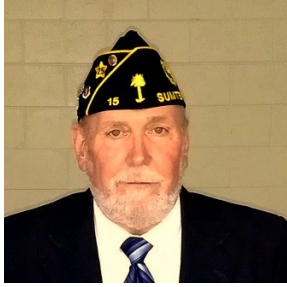
