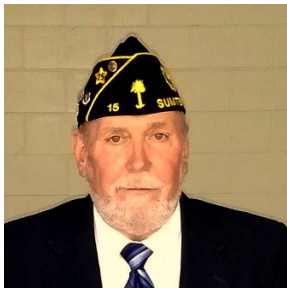


From our Chaplain...
